

Competitor Racing Lane Modification Instructions

To shorten the overall length of the lane by 7':

1. Lay COMPETITOR[®] Racing lane on a flat surface or pool deck.
2. Release all slack on the Take Up Reel, so that the Blue Nylon spool is showing.
3. Locate set-screw on Take Up Reel Spool and loosen.
4. Remove cable from Spool. Please note the way the cable is threaded so re-attachment is done in the proper manner.
5. Using a 20' length of cable. Splice the 20' length to the end of the lane using a small piece of tape. Gently slide off the 15' of solid color. Remove the splice and set aside the 15' section.
6. Remove 7½ sections of alternating colors. Each section is approximately 1'. Re-assemble a half section of contrasting color.
7. Re-attach the splice with the 15' of solid color – gently slide the parts back onto the lane. You should now have the 15' of solid color followed by a ½ section of contrasting color.
8. Remove splice and measure 7' up the cable.
9. Cut cable with small bolt / wire cutters.
10. Re thread cable back onto Take Up Reel Spool (remember to feed cable through the hole with no set screw first).
11. Tighten set screw firmly to complete modification.
