Maintenance Instructions for Competitor® Lane Lines

- Maintain lane lines to get the longest life possible.
- Cleaning lanes can be critical in stopping the deterioration process.
- Wash lanes with clean water and sodium phosphate, which acts as a detergent.
- Store lanes with a cover over them to help keep harmful ultraviolet (UV) light rays away.
- Of course, this requires pulling the lanes out of the pool every day, which may seem like a hassle, but can make the difference between getting three years or five years of performance from the lanes.
- Body oils and bacteria that rise to the surface can deteriorate the plastic, causing a reduction in life.
- Using the Competitor® Stor-Lane® Reel with cover will prolong the life of your new lane lines.
- Competitor® Stainless steel cables have a vinyl coating to help protect lane lines from excessive wear.
